Showstoppers: Big Broadway Moments – SYNOPSIS

Showstoppers: Big Broadway Moments is a high-energy concert celebration of **90-minutes** without interval of musical theatre at its most thrilling. Bringing together a curated selection of iconic numbers from some of the greatest and most beloved musicals ever performed, the production showcases the songs that stopped the show, defined an era, and continue to captivate audiences around the world. From soaring ballads and electrifying anthems to dazzling ensemble numbers and unforgettable character pieces, *Showstoppers* places the spotlight firmly on the moments audiences wait for the big songs, the bold emotions, and the sheer theatrical joy.

This show provides an opportunity for many cast members to have lead roles.

Performed by outstanding soloists, vocal ensemble and orchestra, this concert-style event is a vibrant tribute to Broadway's power to entertain, inspire and exhilarate, delivering a performance of music that is anything but ordinary.

FEES and MEMBERSHIP

There is a one-off Participation Fee of \$60 to participate as a cast member in *Showstoppers*. All cast must be members of WTC, a full year WTC membership is \$40 full fee or \$30 concession (year ending Dec 2026). Apply for membership on the WTC website, www.warrnambooltheatrecompany.com. Please let us know if these fees are a barrier to your participation, as we are here to help. Membership to WTC and participation fee can be paid at the same time.

REHEARSALS

Rehearsals are currently locked in for **Tuesdays: Ensemble/Choreography** and **Saturdays: Soloists with Orchestra**, but this is subject to change (see appendix 1). When cast and items have been finalised, a comprehensive rehearsal schedule will be provided. Rehearsals will be at TOAD Hall, corner Manifold and Princess Street Warrnambool. Cast may not be required for all sessions but will be allocated specific times, where attendance is required. If you have any concerns about your ability to fit in with this schedule, please discuss with the Directorial team. Any absences that you are already aware of (e.g., a booked holiday) should be listed on your audition form.

Please note, by accepting a role in this production, you are committing to rehearsals as scheduled. Please show your respect for the production team and your fellow cast members by advising the Directorial team of your absence as soon as possible so that we may also plan the detailed rehearsal schedule around your plans.

AUDITIONS

Auditions will comprise a 10-minute individual vocal audition. Dance auditions will be held in groups of four following individual auditions. More information about audition components below. Auditions will be held at TOAD Hall on the following dates:

If you are unable to attend these audition dates, you will be able to submit your audition by video before Saturday 28th February - please contact WTC.

Vocal Audition

You will be able to sing up to 3 of the listed musical items that you would prefer to solo in. Please discuss with us if you are only wanting to be in the vocal ensemble.

Backing tracks will be provided for all items and are available at www.warrnambooltheatrecompany.com. Auditionees are encouraged to choose up to 3 items to sing to enable quick casting. Should you wish to sing one of the duet/trio items, it would be beneficial to audition as a group if you can, and each book your audition spots one after the other in succession.

Dance Audition

There will be no dance auditions during the audition weekend. If you can indicate your abilities and previous repertoire in your audition application so we can discuss with you during your audition.

Call Back Auditions (if required)

Those who receive a call back will be asked to perform alternate items, and possibly in groups, which will be given on the day. Call backs may not occur for every item.

CASTING

Once casting is complete, all auditionees will be contacted by phone and email. All successful applicants will need to complete membership forms and pay the respective fees before the first rehearsal.

MUSICAL ITEMS

Showstoppers: Big Broadway Moments requires approximately 40 solo performers with the possibility of some cast performing multiple items, with total vocal ensemble up to 50 or more depending on auditions. There will be a short list of approximately 20 items from the following list which will be chosen based on what you bring to the audition. These items will require strong singers with some of them needing dancing. Some items require the addition of the vocal ensemble, and few requiring all of the above. The production calls for a diverse cast, and every character, young and old, is an integral part of this wonderful production.

If you are not looking for a solo part, but are only looking to join the vocal ensemble, please book and complete your audition as normal and let us know.

The opening number is locked in for the production. This will be The Greatest Show from The Greatest Showman, and the “The Showman” character will be the narrator. If you believe you have the acting ability, charisma and talent to take on this role, please audition for it.
